1) RED CROSSBILL (Fichtenkreuzschnabel)

This big finch has a
oddly shaped, crossed beak,

Who of the two has a continuous red crown on his head?

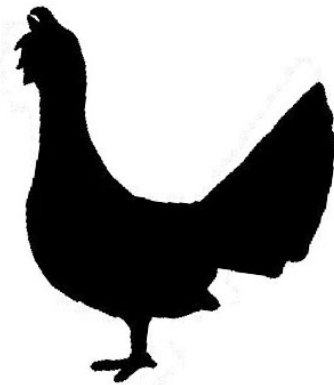
- male

- has a spur on the leg

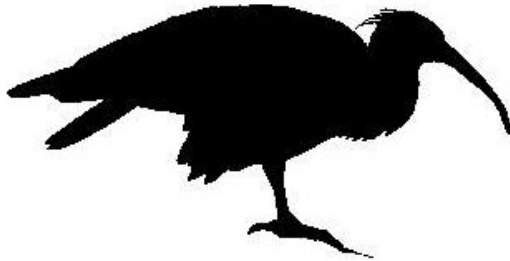
8) CHOUGH (Alpenkrähe)
